

## The Wordless Book Colors Explained

Gold - Reminds us of God's love and how He has prepared a special place for each one of His children in Heaven where we will be a part of His Forever Family. (John 3:16)

Dark - Reminds us of the sin in our lives. Sin is anything we think, say or do that displeases God. God cannot allow sin into heaven. Sin must be punished and the punishment for sin is to be separated from God forever. But God has a wonderful plan so that we won't have to be punished for our sin. (Romans 3:23 and 13:12)

Red - Reminds us of the blood that Jesus shed on the cross to take the punishment for our sins. His blood is the only thing that can cleanse us of our sins. (I Corinthians 15:3-4 and Hebrews 10:22)

Clean - Reminds us that we can have a clean heart because of the price that Jesus paid for our sins on the cross. If you admit that you are a sinner and believe in your heart that Christ died for your sins and call on Him to forgive you of your sins, you will be saved. (John 1:12)

Green - Reminds us of things that grow. As a child of God, we too can grow. We can grow in prayer, in the reading of His Word, in fellowship with other believers, and by telling others about God's wonderful Gospel story. (II Peter 3:18)

So, how about you? Have you made the choice to receive Jesus into your life? I want everyone to close their eyes and bow their heads because I have a very important question to ask all of you. Can you clearly remember a time when you asked Jesus to come into your life? Maybe you prayed at a Vacation Bible School to receive Jesus or maybe it was with Mom or Dad or a Sunday School Teacher. If you can clearly remember a time when you asked Jesus into your life, I'd like you to raise your hand up nice and high so I can see it. Awesome! Very good! You can put your hands down now. Everyone's eyes should still be closed. Now some of you did not raise your hand.

Maybe that was because you've never asked Jesus into your life or maybe you're not sure if you've ever asked Jesus into your life. If you would like to be sure today that Jesus is in your life, I would like you to raise your hand nice and high. Remember, all eyes should still be closed. Very good! Now I would like to pray for everyone. "Dear Jesus, thank you Lord for the children who have already asked You into their lives. I pray that You would help them grow in you more and more everyday. And now, Jesus, I pray for those kids who just raised their hands showing that they want to ask You into their lives today. Please give them the courage and understanding to make this very important decision. Everyone's eyes shoud still be closed. If you were one of those who just raised their hand to ask Jesus into their life today, I am going to ask that you would stand up right where you are. Excellent! That is awesome! And finally, just one more thing, those of you who are standing, I'm going to ask that you come up here to the front and stand with me so I can help you to pray and ask Jesus to come into your life. (At this point, any children who came forward to stand with you should be led in a prayer of salvation. The following prayer is the one I use and I do it in "Echo" fashion - in other words they repeat after me.) "Dear Jesus, I know that I am a sinner. Sometimes I do wrong things that displease You. But God, I know You sent Your Son, Jesus, to die on the cross for my sins. I believe that by His blood that He shed, all my sins are washed away. Now, Jesus, help me grow in You more and more everyday and someday Jesus I will live in Heaven with You forever and ever. I love You, Jesus. In Your name I pray. Amen.
