This game was designed to be played in conjuction with the multiple choice questions you will find within this game kit. However, you can also play this game by itself or with any other kind of review questions. Just follow the directions below and have FUN!

Have you ever lost something? I know I have. Countless of times! You search and search and once you find the missing item, a huge flood of relief comes over you. Here is a fun game to help your elementary kids gain a better understanding of how incredibly excited God gets when one of His children is found

and comes home to the Father.


Assembly: Cut out all cards along the black lines. Except for the Multiple Choice Question Cards, back all the rest of the cards with the small title backings and then laminate all the cards so that they will last for a long time.

Set Up: Place all 36 of the sheep, coin and prodigal son cards onto a pocket chart that you can display on an easel or you could lay them out on a table with the title backing side showing. Place the "Number" cards in a bag or bucket and finally, place your 2 rectangular title cards up at the top of your pocket chart. You do not need to keep score for this game.

How to Play: Divide your children into 2 teams. Tell the children they are going to learn about the "Lost and Found Parables" of Jesus. Let them know that behind all the cards on the pocket chart there are 3 kinds of cards – Sheep cards, coin cards and prodigal son cards. If a child from a team correctly answers the multiple choice question, he or she will then get to reach into the bag of number cards to see how many cards they will be allowed to pick off of the board. The number cards give you the choice of picking one, two or three cards with another number card giving you the chance to take a card from the other team. The first team who finds **2 of each** of the sheep, coin or prodigal son cards wins! Keep each team's cards in separate areas.

For some added fun, I encourage the kids to say the following phrases or sounds after each sheep, coin or prodigal son card is turned over: For the sheep, we say, "BaaaaaH!", for the coin we say, "Jingle, Jingle" and for the prodigal son we say, "So sad, poor lad!".




