


Little children love animals! Maybe that's why the story of Noah's Ark is a favorite among preschoolers. Here is a fun "Bingo" type game that will not only remind your little ones about Noah's big floating zoo, but they will be presented with different Scriptures that showcase different animals of the Bible.

Assembly: Cut out all the animal/scripture cards along the black lines. There are 3 different Noah's Ark boards. Print enough boards so that each child in your class will have one of the three boards. Laminate all of the cards and Noah's Ark boards for longterm use. Place all of the animal cards each in their own envelope. (Letter size is fine.) On the outside of each envelope, attach the Scripture that goes with the animal.

Set Up: Give each child a Noah's Ark board along with 5 "markers" with which to cover up their animals. The "markers" could be pennies or pieces of paper, for example. Place all 15 envolopes in your hand in a "fanning" style.

How to Play: Tell the children that they are going to learn about some animals that were on Noah's Ark that come straight out of the Bible. Explain that you will let one child pick an envolope from your hand. You will then read the Scripture outloud and ask the children what animal was mentioned in the Scripture. After they all shout out the correct answer, take out the picture of the animal from the envelope to show the children that they guessed correctly. Proceed to ask them who has that particular animal on their Noah's Ark board. If a child has the animal, encourage them to cover it up with their marker. When a child fills up all 5 animals on their board they should shout out, "I filled up Noah's Ark!" Have everyone take off all of their markers and exchange Noah's Ark boards and play again.
