Script

(Make Marvin ring his little bell.)

(Wait for responses.)

(Look around.)

Hold on, Marvin! I'm coming!

(Put on Marvin's puppet box.)

(Jingle)

Marvin says it's good to be here.

Boys and girls, can you say, "Hello!" to Marvin?

(Wait for responses.)

You came to visit us on just the right day. We are talking about God's beautiful gardens.

(Jingle)

Marvin says he loves God (Jingle) and his gardens.

Me too, Marvin! So what do we owe the pleasure of this visit?

(Jingle)

Marvin says he wants to play a game with us. Really? (Jingle)

We'd love to play a game with you. How do we play? (Jingle)

Marvin says he will tell us about some different flowers that he likes to crawl on.

OK. And then what.

(Jingle)

Marvin says after we learn about each flower, we will have to count how many petals are on each flower.

We can do that. My friends are very good counters.

(Jingle)

Marvin says that he will then make a sound to show if we counted correctly.

What kind of sound, Marvin.

(Jingle)

Marvin says it will sound like this.

(Play the pretty bell sound provided for you.)

This sounds fun.

(Jingle)

Marvin wants to know if we are ready. Are we ready, boys and girls?

(Wait for responses.)

This flower is a rose.

It stands lovely and tall.

It's petals are red

Which reminds us of God's love for all.

How many petals are on the rose? (Count)

Did we get it right, Marvin? (Pretty Bell Sound)

How many petals are on the gardenia? (Count)
Did we get it right, Marvin? (Pretty Bell Sound)

This flower is a tulip
It's pink petals are like a kiss
From a loving family member
Like Mom or Dad or even sis

How many petals are on the tulip? (Count)
Did we get it right, Marvin? (Pretty Bell Sound)

This flower is a daisy.
God made it's petals white.
It is pure and lovely
It reminds us to do what's right.

How many petals are on the daisy? (Count)
Did we get it right, Marvin? (Funny Honking Sound)
Excuse you! Marvin! what kind of sound was that? (Jingle)
