



Clothe Yourselfes with Love: A Bible Game for Preschoolers

What you will need:

Gather the following five pieces of winter clothing and hang them on a clothesline for all the children to see: a coat, a scarf, earmuffs, a hat and mittens. Remember to choose a size of coat that will fit your average preschooler.

You will need to make 5 cards using the graphics I have given you. The fronts

will have numbers 1 through 5 on them. Each of the backs will contain a picture of one of the items of clothing you have gathered along with a little poem. Create these cards and place them on a chart or table, poem side down, so that all the children can easily see them.

How to play:

Choose a child to be the one who gets "clothed in God's love" with the pieces of clothing.

Next, have a different child come up and pick up card #1. Have them turn the card over and you will read what the poem says. Ask the children what kind of clothing does the picture show. Let that same child go and find the piece of clothing and give it to the main child who is getting "clothed in God's love." Have that child put on the piece of clothing. Continue to play in the same way with the other 4 pieces of winter wear.
